<b>Attractions Introduction :</b>	<p><b>Wulai Waterfall</b></p>  <p>In the suburb of Taipei, Wulai is the home of Atayal tribes. Traditional tribal dance and rituals will be performed for visitors. If you wish, you may join them in dancing. You can also enjoy the sight of a gushing waterfall amidst the lush green landscape, take an exciting cable-car ride across the gorge, or take a hot-spring bath . When visiting Wulai, you have three routes to choose from. One takes you to the Wulai Scenic Area, where you can view the waterfall and take the cable car across the gorge to Yunxian Park. The second covers the Neidong Forest Recreation Area, where you can savor the beauties of nature and bask in a "green shower." The third follows the Tonghou River for seven or eight kilometers; it is an ideal route for bird-watchers, especially in the winter time.</p>
