| Attractions Introduction : | <p>Sanhsia</p>  <p>Sanhsia is highly valued in culture and has many traditional artisans. The scenery spots include Zushi Temple, Li Mei-Shu Memorial Hall, and White Chicken Art Village. The three spots are filled with private cultural artifacts. Zushi Temple of dedicated engravings and complicated columns won the name of "Art Palace". Besides Zushi Temple, other places such as Sanhsia Bridge, Shangdigong Temple, ancient tablets, memorial tablets, ancient battlefield, old street, old farmers' association building, and historical artifacts museum are worthy of appreciation.</p> <p>Yingko</p> <p>Yingko is known as the center of pottery industry in Taiwan. There are nearly 800 ceramic factories and shops in Yingko, producing and displaying every imaginable kind of ceramic work. For this reason, the town has been dubbed the "Jingdezhen" of Taiwan, in reference to the famed ceramics capital of mainland China. Lined with shops, Yiggko's Wenhua Road, Jianshanpu Street, Jungjeng 1st Road, and the pottery market on Jungshan Road are crowded with people, especially during the "Pottery Festival" in summer when the abundance and the diversity of pottery is widely promoted by means of demonstration, exhibition, and multi-media introduction.</p>  |
